

# How to use bus

Getting on and off a bus / Manners when using a bus

## Getting on a bus

### STEP.1 Before boarding

Only Japanese yen is accepted, so have some yen coins in advance for smooth bus use.  
(On the bus, you can exchange only coins and 1,000-yen bills.)



### STEP.2 Waiting at the bus stop

- Check your destination and timetable at the bus stop. After your bus arrives, do not step off the sidewalk until the door opens.
- When buses arrive, check their destination on the sign.
- If you are not certain if the bus will go to your destination, ask the driver.

### STEP.3 Boarding the bus

- Board from the entrance.
- Form one line when boarding.



- Take one **numbered ticket**, which will be required when getting off the bus. You will pay the fare when getting off.



### STEP.4 On the bus

To prevent accidents on the bus, always take a seat when the bus is running, or if you are standing, hold the strap or handrail.



## Getting off a bus

### STEP.5 Before getting off a bus

The name of your destination bus stop will be shown on the fare indicator set at the front. Press the closest **stop button** before getting off.

\*If no one presses the button, the bus may pass the stop.

For safety reasons, do not stand up until the bus completely stops and the door opens.

### STEP.6 Checking the fare

Check the fare indicator set at the front and the number of your ticket. Be sure to have exact change ready.

Check the fare under the same number of your ticket number.  
\*220 yen in this case



### STEP.7 Paying the fare

Check the fare indicator and your ticket's number, and put the fare in the fare box.



#### Coin changer

Exchange of money is accepted only from coins and 1,000-yen bills. As bills with a value of 2,000 yen or more cannot be exchanged, have a 1,000-yen bill or coins ready before boarding.

### STEP.8 Getting off a bus

- Check your luggage and belongings and do not leave anything behind.
- Get off at the exit.
- When getting off, watch your step and watch out for bicycles or others on the street.
- Running out into the street after getting off the bus is dangerous.
